Noah graduates from college this month.

In May, Noah Blake will graduate from SUNY Oswego with a degree in broadcasting—one of Succeed2gether’s first success stories that started 10 years ago.

Noah never thought of himself as college material because when he was in middle school, he was failing math and struggling in many subjects. But through Succeed2gether’s one-on-one tutoring, which he received for free throughout middle school and high school, he began to excel academically. Tutoring his family would not have been able to afford.

Soon he was doing so well that he became a tutor for other children in Succeed2gether's program, and spent his summer vacations working at our Summer Enrichment Program. In his junior year of high school, Noah came to us for help with his college applications. He was thrilled to be accepted to multiple colleges and became the first in his family to go on to higher education. Noah and his four siblings have all received assistance through Succeed2gether's educational enrichment programs. Noah is just one of hundreds of children that Succeed2gether has helped with the free programs we offer, including tutoring, a summer enrichment program, and after-school workshops in subjects

such as math, writing, robotics, violin and nutrition. Our goal is to provide support from kindergarten through high school.

# What is Succeed2gether?

Succeed2gether is a non-profit organization based in Montclair that addresses unequal access to educational resources by providing free, high-quality enrichment and academic programs for hundreds of children in need from Montclair and Essex County.

## Our programs:

- After-school one-on-one tutoring for students in grades 1 through 12.
- Book buddy and math buddy programs for younger students (K-2 grades) who need help with reading comprehension, fluency, or counting, addition/subtraction and number sense.
- After-school and weekend enrichment workshops such as: writing, music, robotics, app development, as well as coping with stress and anxiety.
- Summer enrichment program and workshops shown to be effective in reducing the “summer slide”
- The Fourth Annual Montclair Literary Festival, for children and adults, will be held March 25-29, 2020. Save the date!
